OUR LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

CHILDCARE SUPPORT

Support HF 3681/SF3790, a bill designed to increase access to and affordability of high-quality childcare programs by ensuring that no family pays more than 7% of income and factors provider costs into reimbursements.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Support the Governor's 2024 Infrastructure Plan, which includes \$5 million in grants to construct and renovate early childhood facilities and help ensure families have access to early childhood programs housed in safe facilities.

STRENGTHENING THE WORKFORCE

Continued Investment in the Retaining Early Educators through Attaining Incentives Now (REETAIN) Grant Program. This program, established in 2023, provides competitive grants to incentivize well-trained childcare professionals to remain in the workforce.
